Minutes: Relating to Fences and the updating of the Statute..

Senator John (Jack) T. Traynor, Chairman called the Judiciary committee to order. All Senators were present. The hearing opened with the following testimony:

Testimony In Support of the Bill:

Wade Mooser, ND Stockman's Assoc. (meter 2629) Introduced the Resolution. After a review of the laws. The most frequently asked question is about property lines and fences going through and on and who owns them. People transfer property do not know if they own the fence, who should maintain it. If one side has cattle and the other does not... We need to have more clarification on the ownership and maintenance of.

Sen. Randy Christmann, Dist. #3 - Introduced the bill. This issue came up out of my district with a common problem of two ranchers; one keeps up the fence and the other does not. The way the wire is attached to the post determines if the cattle stay in. If it is the wrong side then the cattle can easily push it off the post. Sited problems. After researching the law we realized that

it was a hundred years old. We no longer have "fence watchers" who mandates the policing of this? This has the potential of legal conflict.

Sen. Trenbeath stated that this was the first time he has reviewed the "fences" portion of the code and agreed with Sen. Christmann 100%, it is outdated and confusing. Last review of the law was 1943, original law was 1903.

Terry Traynor - Association of Counties. We support the bill (meter 3200) The County Commissioners would welcome a review of this statute. It appears that when a township is unorganized the County ends up with falling into the role of "fence viewers". They get in the middle of what really is a civil mater that should be before a judge. This is a difficult and unclear law. Sometimes it has become very costly due to the fact that they have to survey and reestablish monument markers and things to sort out where the correct placement of the fence is.

Senator Syverson questioned the counties responsibility to satisfy these problems? Yes, sited a case in Morton County (meter 3450).

Minutes: Rep.Devlin, Chairman was sponsor on the resolution and elected to present the background as Sen. Christmann was not available at this time. Rep. Herbal, Vice Chairman Chaired the meeting while Chairman Devlin discussed the resolution. It asks the Legislative Council to study the various fencing laws that counties and townships deal with --- many of them are a hundred years old. There is a feeling that many of them are outdated -- in fact some may be creating problems for political subdivisions. On the Senate side they exempted out all of the cities -- because that wasn't the intent.

Rep. Ekstrom (9.7) Some neighbors in Fargo have had some contentious moments about maintaining their fence -- that wouldn't be covered under these studies?

Rep.Devlin, -- No-- this is strictly rural.

Rep. Kretschmar (10.9) There used to be a law that the County Commissioners were designated to settle fencing disputes -- when you were a county commissioner - - did you ever get involved in that?
