- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to nonresident fishing license fees; and to amend and reenact
- 3 section 20.1-03-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to nonresident fishing licenses.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-03-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 20.1-03-10. Contents of nonresident general game, fishing, or reciprocal trapping

8 licenses - Licenses not transferable - Nonresident short-term fishing license. A

9 nonresident general game, fishing, or reciprocal trapping license is not transferable. Each

10 license must:

11 1. Describe the licensee.

- 12 2. Designate the licensee's place of residence.
- 13 3. Have printed upon it in large figures the year for which it is issued.
- Have printed upon it in large letters the words "nonresident license" and
 "nontransferable".
- 16 5. Have connected to it detachable shipping tags as the director may deem advisable.
- 17 6. Be issued in the name of the director.
- 18 In addition to the regular nonresident fishing license, a nonresident short-term fishing license
- 19 <u>licenses</u> may be issued. This license is <u>These licenses are</u> valid up to seven days <u>or ten days</u>
- 20 from the date of issue.
- 21 SECTION 2. A new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code
- 22 is created and enacted as follows:
- 23 For a nonresident short-term ten-day fishing license, twenty-five dollars.
