Was read the first time and referred to the Political Subdivisions Committee.

Reps. Kerzman, Froelich, Kempenich and Sen. Erbele introduced:

**HB 1338:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 20.1-01-17, 20.1-01-18, 20.1-01-19, and 20.1-01-20 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to hunting on private lands.

Was read the first time and referred to the Natural Resources Committee.

Reps. Kerzman, DeKrey, Froelich and Sen. Lyson introduced:

**HB 1339:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 20.1-03-07 and section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to small game hunting by nonresidents; and to repeal section 20.1-08-04.9 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to hunting by nonresidents.

Was read the first time and referred to the Natural Resources Committee.

Reps. Dosch, Charging, Kasper and Sens. Dever, Espegard introduced:

**HB 1340:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 6-05.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to locations for multiple offices of a subsidiary trust company.

Was read the first time and referred to the Industry, Business and Labor Committee.

Reps. Kasper, Dosch, Grande, Headland, Klein, Skarphol introduced:

**HB 1341:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 54-44.4-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to approved vendors for state commodities and services contracts.

Was read the first time and referred to the Government and Veterans Affairs Committee.

Reps. Weisz, Drovdal, Ruby and Sen. Trenbeath introduced:

**HB 1342:** A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 59 of section 39-01-01 and sections 39-29-01, 39-29-01.1, 39-29-02, 39-29-03, 39-29-04, 39-29-05, 39-29-06, 39-29-07, 39-29-08, 39-29-09, 39-29-10, 39-29-12, 51-20-01, and 57-40.3-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to all-terrain vehicles.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Transportation Committee**.

Reps. Froelich, Damschen, DeKrey, Kerzman and Sens. Erbele, Taylor introduced:

**HB 1343:** A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to hunting on nonposted land.

Was read the first time and referred to the Natural Resources Committee.

#### FIRST READING OF HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTIONS

Reps. Belter, Carlson and Sens, Christmann, Wardner introduced:

**HCR 3004:** A concurrent resolution to create and enact a new section to article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota, relating to the vote required to enact an income, sales, use, or motor vehicle excise taxes increase by the legislative assembly.

Was read the first time and referred to the Constitutional Revision Committee.

Reps. Skarphol, Glassheim, Svedjan and Sens. Andrist, Klein introduced:

HCR 3005: A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the utilization of land owned by state agencies and institutions, the best use of state-owned land, and whether the state should establish an inventory of state-owned land.

Was read the first time and referred to the Agriculture Committee.

Reps. Maragos, Kretschmar and Sens. Flakoll, Syverson introduced: **HCR 3006:** A concurrent resolution recognizing Roger Maris on his major league baseball career and urging the Committee on Baseball Veterans of the Baseball Hall of Fame to elect Roger Maris to the Baseball Hall of Fame.

Was read the first time and referred to the Political Subdivisions Committee.
