

Phase II Catalyst Initiative

Purpose

- Re-use (Foundation Layer leverages Phase I components)
- Recapture lost functionality (Conference Committee System)
- Mitigate risk (Business Processes Validation)
- Forward momentum

Timeframe and Costs (Total of \$737,397)

- Foundation Layer, 113 days (est.), \$316,462
- Conference Committee System, 16 days (est.) \$49,680
- Business Processes Validation, 74 days (est.), \$131,321
- Training, \$17,100
- Travel, \$74,619 (est.)
- NDLC Costs for Hw/Sw, 3rd Party Consulting \$148,215



In Summary

Phase II should start as soon as possible

- Two year time horizon presses against '09 Biennium
- Maximize ROI sooner
- Mitigate organizational risk

PTC is ready to move forward with NDLC

- Would prefer to start broader Phase II Implementation effort now
- Will commence with Phase II Catalyst Initiative, if NDLC constraints deem necessary
- Request NDLC authorization to move forward
