**REENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2379**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a nursing education consortium to establish a mobile clinical  
2 nursing simulation laboratory; to provide statements of legislative intent; to provide for a report  
3 to the legislative council; to provide an appropriation; and to provide a continuing appropriation.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. Nursing education consortium - Continuing appropriation.**

- 6 1. The university of North Dakota college of nursing shall establish and administer a  
7 nursing education consortium for the purpose of addressing common concerns in  
8 nursing education which produce obstacles in meeting the state's current and  
9 future nursing needs, with a focus on the specific needs of rural communities.
- 10 2. The consortium membership must include representation of the university of North  
11 Dakota college of nursing, the university of North Dakota center for rural health,  
12 and the board of nursing. In addition, each nursing program in this state which is  
13 approved by the board of nursing and each nursing program with approval pending  
14 which is located in this state must be invited to have representation in the  
15 consortium. The consortium members may invite interested persons to join the  
16 consortium membership or to participate in consortium activities. Interested  
17 persons may include the North Dakota nurses association nursing practice council  
18 leadership team; North Dakota hospital association; workforce partners, including  
19 job service North Dakota, the department of commerce division of workforce  
20 development, rural leadership of North Dakota, and the North Dakota workforce  
21 development council; employer partners; and other interested public and private  
22 parties. The dean of the university of North Dakota college of nursing shall serve  
23 as chairman of the consortium from July 1, 2007, through December 31, 2009.

- 1           during which the dean shall report to the legislative council. After 2009, the  
2           chairman must be chosen by the members.
- 3           3. If the consortium secures nonstate funds to cover the capital costs of a mobile  
4           clinical nursing simulation laboratory program, the consortium may establish a  
5           mobile clinical nursing simulation laboratory program to travel the state and  
6           provide clinical education for nursing students of nursing education programs in  
7           the state and provide clinical education on current and emerging approaches to  
8           nursing excellence to medical facility staff.
- 9           4. If the consortium establishes a mobile clinical nursing simulation laboratory  
10           program, the consortium shall establish a strategic plan for the ongoing activities of  
11           the simulation laboratory program, including goals and benchmarks for the  
12           implementation of the simulation laboratory program.
- 13           5. The consortium may contract with a third party in conducting the duties of the  
14           consortium and may seek, receive, and accept from any source aid or  
15           contributions of money, property, labor, or other things of value to be held, used,  
16           and applied to carry out the purposes of the consortium. Any money received by  
17           the consortium as gifts, grants, or donations is appropriated as a continuing  
18           appropriation for the purpose of funding the simulation laboratory program and the  
19           activities of the consortium.

20           **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the  
21 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$200,000, or so much  
22 of the sum as may be necessary, to the university of North Dakota for the purpose of funding  
23 the costs of a simulation laboratory program under section 1 of this Act, for the biennium  
24 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.

25           **SECTION 3. STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION - LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It  
26 is the intent of the legislative assembly that the state board of higher education establish and  
27 implement a policy and procedure for institutions of higher education under the control of the  
28 board to participate in systemwide initiatives.

29           **SECTION 4. COMPETITIVE GRANT ELIGIBILITY - LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the  
30 intent of the legislative assembly that the nursing education consortium apply for public and  
31 private grants to assist in financing section 1 of this Act and that state agencies interpret grant

- 2 for grants.
