1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the veterans' home
2 and department of veterans' affairs; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION.** The amounts identified in this
5 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the veterans' home and
6 department of veterans' affairs in section 3 of this Act as follows:

19 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
20 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
21 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
22 other income, to the veterans' home and department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of
23 defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending
24 June 30, 2009, as follows:

10 **SECTION 4. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO**

11 **SIXTY-FIRST LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The total general fund appropriation in section 3 of
12 this Act includes \$630,000 for the veterans' home and \$59,606 for the department of veterans'
13 affairs for the one-time funding items identified in this section. This amount is not a part of the
14 agencies' base budgets to be used in preparing the 2009-11 executive budget. The veterans'
15 home and department of veterans' affairs shall report to the appropriations committees of the
16 sixty-first legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning
17 July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009.

22 **SECTION 5. EMERGENCY.** The appropriation of \$630,000 included in subdivision 1
23 of section 3 of this Act for life safety improvements is declared to be an emergency measure.
