1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 39-06-03.1 and subsection 1 of

2 section 39-06-19 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to expiration of operator's licenses

3 and nondriver photo identification cards.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 39-06-03.1 of the North Dakota
6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 7 1. The director shall issue upon request a nondriver color photo identification card to 8 any North Dakota resident who fulfills the requirements of this section. An 9 application for an identification card must be made on a form furnished by the 10 director. The application must provide for the voluntary identification of the 11 applicant as a donor under the provisions of chapter 23-06.2. If requested on the 12 identification card application, the identification card issued by the director must 13 include a statement making an anatomical gift under chapter 23-06.2. If the 14 person is under the age of eighteen or at least the age of eighteen and under the age of twenty-one, the photo must be against the same color background required 15 16 on a motor vehicle operator's license for an operator of that age. Subject to the 17 provisions of subsection 1 of section 39-06-19, identification cards expire eight 18 years from the date of issue and may be renewed. 19 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 39-06-19 of the North Dakota 20 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 21 Every operator's license issued under this chapter expires and is renewed 1.
- 22 according to this section. The expiration date of an operator's license for a person 23 whose birth occurred in a year ending in an odd numeral is twelve midnight on the 24 anniversary of the birthday in the second subsequent year ending in an odd

| 8 | adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence |
| 9 | or conditional permanent residence status in the United States will be issued a |
| 10 | temporary operator's license or nondriver photo identification card. The temporary |
| 11 | operator's license or identification card is valid only during the period of time of the |
| 12 | applicant's authorized stay in the United States or, if there is no definite end to the |
| 13 | period of authorized stay, a period of one year. The license or card may be |
| 14 | renewed only upon presentation of valid documentary evidence that the status has |
| 15 | been extended. |
