- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 61-34-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to drought livestock water assistance program applications and maximum payments.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 61-34-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **61-34-04. Eligibility Application for assistance.** Applicants with livestock water supply problems caused by drought may apply for assistance from the program. An applicant
- 8 must first apply for water cost-share assistance from the agriculture stabilization and
- 9 conservation service. If cost share assistance is denied by the service, the applicant may
- 10 forward the application to the commission for consideration. An application forwarded to the
- 11 commission must include a document from the agriculture stabilization and conservation
- 12 service stating the reason for denial of cost share assistance. The state engineer shall review
- 13 all applications received by the commission. If the state engineer approves an application, the
- 14 applicant may receive up to fifty sixty-five percent of the cost of the project, but in no event
- more than three four thousand five hundred dollars per project with a limit of three projects per
- 16 application. The state engineer shall provide funds for approved applications in accordance
- 17 with rules and criteria for eligibility and only to the extent that funding is available.
