

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT
with Conference Committee Amendments
ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1009**

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state fair
2 association; and to provide for a report to the budget section.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION.** The amounts identified in this
5 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the state fair association in
6 section 3 of this Act as follows:

7 Capital assets	\$210,000
8 Premiums	<u>405,000</u>
9 Total general fund - Base level	\$615,000

10 **SECTION 2. FUNDING ADJUSTMENTS OR ENHANCEMENTS INFORMATION.** The
11 amounts identified in this section represent the funding adjustments or enhancements to the
12 base funding level for the state fair association which are included in the appropriation in
13 section 3 of this Act as follows:

14 Capital assets	\$515,000
15 Premiums	<u>37,150</u>
16 Total general fund appropriation - Adjustments/enhancements	\$552,150

17 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION FOR THE STATE FAIR ASSOCIATION.** The funds
18 provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of
19 any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from
20 other income of the state fair association to the state fair association for the purpose of
21 defraying the expenses of the state fair association, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007,
22 and ending June 30, 2009, as follows:

4 **SECTION 4. REPORT TO THE BUDGET SECTION.** The state fair association shall
5 provide a report to the budget section prior to July 1, 2008, regarding the status of constructing
6 a new grandstand on the state fairgrounds, including the status of developing a business plan
7 and the progress of fundraising efforts.
