ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2017

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the game and fish
2 department; and to declare an emergency.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION.** The amounts identified in this
5 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the game and fish
6 department in section 3 of this Act as follows:

19 **SECTION 2. FUNDING ADJUSTMENTS OR ENHANCEMENTS INFORMATION.** The
20 amounts identified in this section represent the funding adjustments or enhancements to the
21 base funding level for the game and fish department which are included in the appropriation in
22 section 3 of this Act as follows:

9 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
10 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the game and fish fund in
11 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal
12 funds and other income, to the game and fish department for the purpose of defraying the
13 expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2009,
14 as follows:

27 **SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - WILDLIFE SERVICES - AGRICULTURE**

28 **COMMISSIONER.** There is appropriated from special funds the sum of \$130,000, or so much
29 of the sum as may be necessary, to the game and fish department to be provided to the
30 agriculture commissioner for the payment of wildlife services for the period beginning with the
31 effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2007.

1 **SECTION 5. EMERGENCY.** The \$800,000 included in the ramp improvements and
2 marina development line item included in section 3 of this Act and the appropriation provided in
3 section 4 of this Act are declared to be emergency measures.
