- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsections 1 and 3 of section 57-39.2-04.2 and
- subsections 1 and 3 of section 57-40.2-04.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to
- 3 the exemption from sales and use tax for materials used in the construction or expansion of
- a wind-powered facility; and to provide an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 57-39.2-04.2 of the North

 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows.
 - 1. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - a. (1) "Environmental upgrade" means an investment greater than twenty-five million dollars or one hundred thousand dollars per megawatt of installed nameplate capacity, whichever is less, in machinery, equipment, and related facilities for reducing emissions or increasing efficiency at an existing power plant.
 - (2) "Environmental upgrade" for purposes of a process unit means an investment greater than one hundred thousand dollars in machinery, equipment, and related facilities for reducing emissions, increasing efficiency, or enhancing reliability of the equipment at a new or existing process unit.
 - b. "Operator" means any person owning, holding, or leasing a power plant or process unit.
 - c. "Power plant" means:

1		(1) An electrical generating plant, and all additions to the plant, which
2		processes or converts coal from its natural form into electrical power
3		and which has at least one single electrical energy generation unit
4		with a capacity of fifty thousand kilowatts or more.
5		(2) A wind-powered electrical generating facility, on which
6		construction is completed before January 1, 2011, and all additions
7		to the facility, which provides electrical power through wind
8		generation and which has at least one single electrical energy
9		generation unit with a nameplate capacity of one hundred kilowatts or
10		more.
11		(3) Any other type of electrical power generating facility excluding the
12		types of power plants identified in paragraphs 1 and 2 which has a
13		capacity of one hundred kilowatts or more and produces electricity for
14		resale or for consumption in a business activity.
15	d.	"Process unit" means an oil refinery or gas processing plant and all
16		adjacent units that are utilized in the processing of crude oil or
17		natural gas.
18	e.	"Production equipment" means machinery and attachment units,
19		other than replacement parts, directly and exclusively used in the
20		generation, transmission, or distribution of electrical energy for sale
21		by a power plant.
22	f.	"Repowering" means an investment of more than two hundred million
23		dollars or one million dollars per megawatt of installed nameplate
24		capacity, whichever is less, in an existing power plant that modifies or
25		replaces the process used for converting coal from its natural form
26		into electrical power.

9	SECTION 3.	AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 57-40.2-04.2 of the North	
10	Dakota Century Cod	de is amended and reenacted as follows.	
11	1. As us	sed in this section, unless the context otherwise requires:	
12	a.	(1) "Environmental upgrade" means an investment greater than	
13		twenty-five million dollars or one hundred thousand dollars per	
14		megawatt of installed nameplate capacity, whichever is less, in	
15		machinery, equipment, and related facilities for reducing emissions or	
16		increasing efficiency at an existing power plant.	
17		(2) "Environmental upgrade" for purposes of a process unit means an	
18		investment greater than one hundred thousand dollars in machinery,	
19		equipment, and related facilities for reducing emissions, increasing	
20		efficiency, or enhancing reliability of the equipment at a new or	
21		existing process unit.	
22	b.	"Operator" means any person owning, holding, or leasing a power	
23		plant or process unit.	
24	C.	"Power plant" means:	
25		(1) An electrical generating plant, and all additions to the plant, which	

1 processes or converts coal from its natural form into electrical power 2. and which has at least one single electrical energy generation unit 3 with a capacity of fifty thousand kilowatts or more. 4 (2) A wind-powered electrical generating facility, on which 5 construction is completed before January 1, 2011, and all additions 6 to the facility, which provides electrical power through wind 7 generation and which has at least one single electrical energy 8 generation unit with a nameplate capacity of one hundred kilowatts or 9 more. 10 (3) Any other type of electrical power generating facility excluding the 11 types of power plants identified in paragraphs 1 and 2 which has a 12 capacity of one hundred kilowatts or more and produces electricity for 13 resale or for consumption in a business activity. 14 d. "Process unit" means an oil refinery or gas processing plant and all 15 adjacent units that are utilized in the processing of crude oil or 16 natural gas. "Production equipment" means machinery and attachment units, 17 e. 18 other than replacement parts, directly and exclusively used in the 19 generation, transmission, or distribution of electrical energy for sale 20 by a power plant. 21 f. "Repowering" means an investment of more than two hundred million 2.2 dollars or one million dollars per megawatt of installed nameplate 23 capacity, whichever is less, in an existing power plant that modifies or 24 replaces the process used for converting coal from its natural form 25 into electric power.

- **SECTION 4. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 3 of section 57-40.2-04.2 of the North 1 2 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows. 3. 3 Sales of tangible personal property, other than production or environmental upgrade equipment, which is used in the construction of new power plants or 4 5 to expand existing power plants or to add environmental upgrades to existing power plants or repowering existing power plants or to add environmental 6 7 upgrades to existing process units are exempt from the tax imposed by this 8 chapter.
- 9 **SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act is effective for taxable events occurring after June 30, 2009.
