Mr. Chairman, members of the committee. My name is Justin Dever. I am the Manager of the Office of Innovation and Strategic Initiatives of the North Dakota Department of Commerce.

One of the responsibilities this office has been given by Commissioner Shane Goettle is coordinating the implementation of the Business Incentive Accountability Law that was approved in 2005.

Background

The Business Incentive Accountability law (N.D.C.C. 54-60.1) was approved during the 2005 legislative session through the passage of House Bill 1203. This law took affect on January 1, 2006 and applies to incentives granted since that date. The law applies to incentives granted to businesses that receive \$25,000 or more of incentives in a given year. The law contains exemptions to certain types of assistance given to businesses, including assistance that is generally available to all businesses or to a general class of similar businesses or assistance to provide job readiness and training services.

The law requires grantors and recipients to enter into Business Incentive Agreements (BIA) before the recipient business receives an incentive. This BIA contains a description of the incentive to be granted as well as job goals for the business to achieve within 2 years. As a condition to receiving incentives, the business is to report annually to the grantor on progress towards the goals contained in the BIA. The grantor reports the information to the Department of Commerce and we compile the information and provide it the legislative council.

Compilation and Summary

The Department of Commerce has the responsibility under N.D.C.C. §54-60.1-07 to file the reports of the state grantors and the compilation and summary with the legislative council. In fulfillment of this responsibility, we are providing a copy of the reports of the state grantors to the Legislative Council staff, and providing a spreadsheet to the Committee members that summarize the information from the state grantors. The information on the spreadsheet includes:

- Number of jobs targeted to be created or retained by each recipient
- Number of job achieved in comparison to the jobs targeted by each recipient
- Average compensation of jobs targeted, including identification of the average benefits and average earnings by each recipient
- Average compensation of jobs created or retained by each recipient

We are also to provide a distribution of business incentives by type of business and by public purpose. We utilized the North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) in order to breakdown the type of business. The breakdown of incentives by business type is as follows.

We used the five public purposes outlined in N.D.C.C. § 54-60.1-01(7). There is some duplication in these numbers as some of business incentives cited more than one public purpose.

The compilation and summary is also to include two additional items: the percentage of business incentives that reached goals within two, three, four, and five years from the benefit date and the percentage of business incentives that did not meet goals and that did not receive repayment. Since this law took effect in 2006, two years has not yet elapsed from any benefit dates so it was not possible to include this information. We will, of course, include this information as appropriate in future years.
