## City Job Development Authorities

NDCC Chapter 40-57.4

- May be created by resolution of the city governing body after a public hearing
- In lieu of establishing a job development authority, the city governing body may enter into a contract with an active industrial development organization.

# Funding for City Job Development Authorities:

- Local levy up of to four mills (NDCC 57-15-10, subsection 28),
- Local sales tax revenues (NDCC 40-05.1),
- Equity positions in new or expanding business (NDCC 40-57.4-03, subsection 12),
- Loan and lease payments, other.

# Financing mechanisms:

- Loans and grants,
- Conveyance of property,
- Equity positions,
- PACE interest buydown,
- Other state and federal programs.

2 mill county levy

Financing: typically interest buydown

### Grand Forks JDA

Grand Forks city sales tax

Loan and lease payments

U.S. Economic Development Admin. revolving loan fund

Financing: loans, grants, interest buydowns, equity investments in two businesses

### Hazen JDA

4 mill levy from City of Hazen

50% of Hazen city sales tax

Financing: partial loan guarantees, rent guarantee

# Jamestown/Stutsman Development Corp.

2006 funding: approx. \$550,000 from Stutsman County,

\$7.3 million from City of Jamestown

Financing: grants, loans, interest buydowns, conveyance of property, equity investment

## Cavalier County JDA, Langdon

4 mill levy from Cavalier County 1/3 of Langdon city sales tax – approx. \$55,000 per year No equity investments Financing: loans, state economic development programs

#### Rolla JDA

City of Rolla sales tax - \$75,000 in 2006 No equity investments

City mill levy Financing: PACE interest buydown, other
