

House Bill No. 1103 House Judiciary Committee Francine Johnson, Executive Director, North Dakota Private Investigation & Security Board January 12, 2009

I am here on behalf of the North Dakota Private Investigation & Security Board to testify in support of House Bill No. 1103.

This bill was submitted to maintain consistency within our current fee structure so that all fees relating to registrations are the same. Rather than having several dollar amounts for the various registrations, the board felt that consistency for all registrations would serve the industry and cause less confusion when making application with this board.

The current fees structure ranges from \$18 per applicant to \$25 per applicant.

The change in the fees would make it consistent throughout the registration process as well as allowing the board to increase or decrease fees according to financial outlooks for the board. The verbiage allows the board to increase the fees up to \$25 but also allows the board to decrease those amounts without a legislative change.

I ask that you pass this proposed bill.
