Mr. Chair, members of the committee:

For the record, I am Lawrence Hopkins, Deputy Treasurer for the Office of State Treasurer. I am here in support of House Bill 1115 relating to the fiscal administrative functions for the State of North Dakota.

Section 1 of this bill removes the Office of State Treasurer from these fiscal administrative duties. The tracking of these limits is now performed by the state wide accounting system. The need for two agencies to track and monitor these transactions was eliminated by the technological advances used in the current accounting system as well as previous accounting systems. The Office of Management and Budget is the designated agency for fiscal oversight of the state wide accounting system.

There is no fiscal note attached to this bill.
