Rep. Kretschmar: Two of the counties in our district use the mail in ballot. Basically it worked very well. One of the criticisms was that commissioners only set up one polling place on election day. It is required by statue by Section 16.1-11.1-01 that HB 1343 would just mean a little more emphasis on the ability of the county commissioners to set up more than one polling place in the county. I do not want any mandates on the county commissioners to do that. It should still be their decision. This bill is almost housekeeping. This makes it a little more explicit that the county can have more than one precinct on election day.

Rep. Nancy Johnson: Doesn't it allow for more than one polling place now?

Rep. Kretschmar: I believe the current law allows them to have more than one; but I just wanted to make it clearer that they can do that if they want to.

Senator Andrist: Opened the hearing on HB 1343, all members present.

Bill Kretschmar: Representative District 28, introduce HB 1343. I put this bill in because some people thought there should have been another polling place. In our county, Ashley and Wishek are the two major towns. There was a polling place in Ashley at the courthouse, but none in Wishek. Under current law, the county commission has the authority to set up more

than one polling place if they so wish. This bill is introduced to clarify; it won't change the law in any way. We want the authority to remain with the county commission. The intent is not to force them to have more than one, if they don't want. This is clearly housekeeping!
