2009 TESTIMONY

HB 1439

Mr. Chairman and members of the Committee:

HB 1439 is introduced as a way to confirm or reject a U.S. Senate seat appointment when there is a vacancy.

This Bill would provide for a committee set up that could meet if there is an appointment. The committee would consist of majority and minority leaders and the Chief Justice.

I thought there should be a process to appoint, but not undermine the decision.
