SB2091 Testimony - Support of SB2091

Mr. Chairman, members of the committee:

For the record, I am Lawrence Hopkins, Deputy Treasurer for the Office of State Treasurer. I am here in support of Senate Bill 2091 relating to gaming and excise tax deposits.

The State Auditor's Office has requested that we clarify the language of 53-06.1-12.

All agencies that collect funds are required to deposit those fund with the State Treasurer. The way this bill is written, it requires the Treasurer's Office to create the deposit for the agency.

These funds have been and should continue to be deposited by the Attorney General's Office with the State Treasurer's Office. Section 1 of this bill replaces the words "state treasurer" with "attorney general" in order to make the section consistent with current operating procedures.

There is no fiscal note attached to this bill.
