The DOCR wishes to increase the Crime Victims Compensation maximum amount of a claim for funeral, cremation and burial expenses. The current rate is set at \$3,000. The last time this eligible expense was increased was in 1997 when the legislature increased it from \$1,500 to \$3,000.

The DOCR feels this eligible expense needs to be increased. In North Dakota it is a benefit that is seldom used by crime victims. During the 03-05 biennium we processed 5 claims; 05-07 biennium we processed 3 claims and to date during the 07-09 biennium we have processed 4 claims.
