

**Sixty-first Legislative Assembly of North Dakota

SENATE BILL NO. 2425

(Senators Heckaman, Holmberg, Krauter, O'Connell, Wardner)  
(Representative Boucher)

AN ACT to create and enact a new subsection to section 54-44-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to requiring the director of the office of management and budget to develop a report for the construction of all facilities occupied by state agencies on the capitol grounds.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

**SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 54-44-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Shall prepare and submit to the legislative council by October 1, 2010, a report including the location, expenses, and square footage requirements of all facilities occupied by each state agency. The report must include recommendations for relocation of any entity to achieve improvements in service to the public along with optimal efficiencies in usage of space and cost. The report must include recommendations within the master plan for construction of buildings on the capitol grounds.
