## Introduction

About \$486 million have been awarded to North Dakota through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act to be distributed through state agencies. Most of the funding will be channeled through three agencies: the Department of Public Instruction, the Department of Human Services, and the Department of Transportation.

During the quarter ended March 31, 2010, 1,967.44 North Dakota jobs were funded with these ARRA funds. The vast majority of these jobs are in public school districts.

In many cases, particularly with state agencies and public school districts, these were not new positions; rather they existed prior to ARRA. When the ARRA funding expires, the positions will revert to their original funding sources. If additional funding is not available, the positions will be eliminated.
