Brady, in response to your request I have attached a pdf file with the requested information.

Several assumptions were made in the response to this request including:

1. Program terminations were not included
2. Program title changes were not included
3. Requests to offer existing programs through distance education were not included
4. Simultaneous requests at several levels (e.g. BS and MS) were counted as one

Also, we did provide a count by campus and a total count (310 programs), which seems like a large number but is less than 35 per year or only an average of about 3 programs per campus per year.

Several institutions listed for one program means that it is a collaborative program offered jointly by the campuses. For example, on the first page, BSC, LRSC, DC-B and WSC work jointly to offer on Practical Nurse program.
