


# What is TBED?

Approach used to help create a climate where firms that constantly innovate and maximize the use of technology can thrive

Emphasis: "grow your own"

Can be powerful partner with conventional economic development's recruitment of companies

## Lessons Learned

- Committed high-level leadership is required that understands:
- Economic impact further down the road than other approaches
- · Research does not always succeed
- · Significant cultural differences between actors
- Action should be based on:
  - · Understanding of needs, capabilities, and gaps
  - Filling gaps to encourage change in private sector behavior



## **Lessons Learned**

- Characteristics of successful TBED programs
  - Three hallmarks for long-term sustainability
    - · Do good work
    - · Measure whether they're doing good work
    - · Telling people they're doing good work
  - Champions from more than one sector (ideally all three)
    - Private sector, university, government (gov or legislature)
  - · Effective management and staff
  - Entrepreneurial in approach/responding to change
