SB 2095 establishes two funds with continuing appropriations -- the Carbon Dioxide Storage Administrative Fund (38-20-14) and the Carbon Dioxide Trust Fund (38-20-15). Fees are to be established by the Industrial Commission and are to be sufficient to cover the costs of the State processing applications and the State's expenses associated with long-term monitoring and management of a closed carbon dioxide storage facility.
