- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 15.1-21-02 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to a high school course in consumer finance.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 15.1-21-02 of the North Dakota
5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 1. In order to be approved by the superintendent of public instruction, each public and
7 nonpublic high school shall make available to each student:
- 8 a. Four units of English language arts;
 - 9 b. Four units of mathematics;
 - 10 c. Four units of science;
 - 11 d. Four units of social studies, including one of world history and one of United
12 States history;
 - 13 e. One-half unit of health;
 - 14 f. One-half unit of physical education during each school year, provided that
15 once every four years the unit must be a concept-based fitness class that
16 includes instruction in the assessment, improvement, and maintenance of
17 personal fitness;
 - 18 g. Two units of fine arts, at least one of which must be music;
 - 19 h. Two units of the same foreign language; ~~and~~
 - 20 i. One-half unit of consumer finance; and
 - 21 j. Two units of career and technical education.
