1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the state department of health for providing
2 emergency medical training grants to rural law enforcement and individuals choosing to
3 become licensed first responders.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
6 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$128,400, or so much
7 of the sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of providing
8 emergency medical training grants to rural law enforcement and individuals choosing to
9 become licensed first responders, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30,
10 2011. For the purposes of this section, rural law enforcement means licensed officers from city
11 police departments of cities with a population under 6,500 and all licensed officers from county
12 sheriffs' offices.
