1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 12.1-31-08 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to the possession or distribution of certain photographs or other visual images; and to
3 provide a penalty.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 12.1-31-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **12.1-31-08. Possession or distribution of certain photographs or other visual**
8 **representations prohibited - Penalty.**

- 9 1. A person is guilty of a class A misdemeanor if, knowing of its character and
10 content, a that person surreptitiously acquires and knowingly possesses or
11 distributes any photograph or other visual representation that exhibits a nude or
12 partially denuded human figure, as defined in section 12.1-27.1-03.1, without the
13 individual's written consent.
- 14 2. A person is guilty of a class B misdemeanor if, knowing of its character and content
15 that person acquires and knowingly possesses or distributes any photograph or
16 visual representation that exhibits a nude or partially denuded figure, as defined in
17 section 12.1-27-03.1, without the individual's consent.
- 18 3. If the photograph or other visual representation is of a minor and possession does
19 not violate section 12.1-27.2-04.1, a parent of the minor may give permission for a
20 person to possess or distribute the photograph or other visual representation.
- 21 4. This section does not apply to any book, as defined in section 12.1-27.1-03.1,
22 photograph, video recording, motion picture film, or other visual representation sold
23 in the normal course of business through wholesale or retail outlets that possess a
24 valid sales tax permit or used by a licensed attorney, attorney's agent, or any other

- 1 person obtaining evidence for a criminal investigation or pending civil action, or by
- 2 a medical professional or a peace officer acting within that person's scope of
- 3 employment.
