

Introduced by

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-20-04.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to the suspension of an individual's driving operator's license.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-20-04.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-20-04.1. Administrative sanction for driving or being in physical control of a**
7 **vehicle while having certain alcohol concentration.**

8 1. After the receipt of a person's operator's license, if taken under section 39-20-03.1
9 or 39-20-03.2, and the certified report of a law enforcement officer and if no written
10 request for hearing has been received from the arrested person under section
11 39-20-05, or if that hearing is requested and the findings, conclusion, and decision
12 from the hearing confirm that the law enforcement officer had reasonable grounds
13 to arrest the person and test results show that the arrested person was driving or in
14 physical control of a vehicle while having an alcohol concentration of at least eight
15 one-hundredths of one percent by weight or, with respect to a person under
16 twenty-one years of age, an alcohol concentration of at least two one-hundredths
17 of one percent by weight at the time of the performance of a test within two hours
18 after driving or being in physical control of a motor vehicle, the director shall
19 suspend the person's operator's license as follows:

20 a. For ninety-one days if the person's driving record shows that, within the five
21 years preceding the date of the arrest, the person has not previously violated
22 section 39-08-01 or equivalent ordinance or the person's operator's license
23 has not previously been suspended or revoked under this chapter and the
24 violation was for an alcohol concentration of at least eight one-hundredths of

- 1 one percent by weight or, with respect to a person under twenty-one years of
2 age, an alcohol concentration of at least two one-hundredths of one percent
3 by weight, and under eighteen one-hundredths of one percent by weight.
- 4 b. For one hundred eighty days if the operator's record shows the person has
5 not violated section 39-08-01 or equivalent ordinance within five years
6 preceding the last violation and the last violation was for an alcohol
7 concentration of at least eighteen one-hundredths of one percent by weight.
- 8 c. For three hundred sixty-five days if the person's driving record shows that,
9 within the five years preceding the date of the arrest, the person has once
10 previously violated section 39-08-01 or equivalent ordinance or the person's
11 operator's license has once previously been suspended or revoked under this
12 chapter with the last violation or suspension for an alcohol concentration
13 under eighteen one-hundredths of one percent by weight.
- 14 d. For two years if the person's driving record shows that within the five years
15 preceding the date of the arrest, the person's operator's license has once
16 been suspended, revoked, or issuance denied under this chapter, or for a
17 violation of section 39-08-01 or equivalent ordinance, with the last violation or
18 suspension for an alcohol concentration of at least eighteen one-hundredths
19 of one percent by weight or if the person's driving record shows that within the
20 five years preceding the date of arrest, the person's operator's license has at
21 least twice previously been suspended, revoked, or issuance denied under
22 this chapter, or for a violation of section 39-08-01 or equivalent ordinance, or
23 any combination thereof, and the suspensions, revocations, or denials
24 resulted from at least two separate arrests with the last violation or
25 suspension for an alcohol concentration of under eighteen one-hundredths of
26 one percent by weight.
- 27 e. For three years if the operator's record shows that within five years preceding
28 the date of the arrest, the person's operator's license has at least twice
29 previously been suspended, revoked, or issuance denied under this chapter,
30 or for a violation of section 39-08-01 or equivalent ordinance, or any
31 combination thereof, and the suspensions, revocations, or denials resulted

1 from at least two separate arrests and the last violation or suspension was for
2 an alcohol concentration of at least eighteen one-hundredths of one percent
3 by weight.

4 2. In the suspension of the person's operator's license the director shall give credit for
5 the time the person was without an operator's license after the day of the offense,
6 except that the director may not give credit for the time the person retained driving
7 privileges through a temporary operator's permit issued under section 39-20-03.1
8 or 39-20-03.2.

9 3. If a court orders the person to participate in an alcohol testing program under which
10 the person is required to participate in a sobriety program under which the person
11 is required to submit to daily testing or monitoring for the presence of alcohol in the
12 person's body if the person violates the provisions of the court order, the director
13 shall suspend the person's operator's license immediately. The director shall
14 suspend the operator's license of a person upon receipt of an order from the court
15 indicating that the person has violated the court order, has been convicted of the
16 offense, or has completed participation in the sobriety program.
