1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a study by the adjutant general of a multidiscipline emergency
2 responder academy; and to provide an appropriation.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. STUDY - MULTIDISCIPLINE EMERGENCY RESPONDER ACADEMY.**

5 During the 2009-10 interim, the adjutant general shall study the feasibility and desirability of
6 establishing a multidiscipline emergency responder academy within the state. The study should
7 address the needs of all emergency responders, the possibility of having a single central
8 location with all necessary equipment and training areas, and the availability of providing mobile
9 training. Before July 1, 2010, the adjutant general shall report the outcomes and
10 recommendations of this study to the legislative council.

11 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
12 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$100,000, or so much
13 of the sum as may be necessary, to the adjutant general for the purpose of conducting the
14 study required in section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending
15 June 30, 2011.
