BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. STUDY NEXT GENERATION 911. During the 2009-10 interim, the
 adjutant general shall study the effects of next generation 911 on the public safety answering
 points in the state. The study must address the technology needs relating to next generation
 911 and any necessary changes to the current 911 funding model. Before July 1, 2010, the
- 8 adjutant general shall report the outcomes and recommendations of this study to the legislative
- SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$100,000, or so much
 of the sum as may be necessary, to the adjutant general for the purpose of conducting the
- 13 study required in section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending
- 14 June 30, 2011.
