1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 39-29-09 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to the operation of off-highway vehicles.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 39-29-09 of the North Dakota
5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 1. An individual may not operate an off-highway vehicle on the roadway, shoulder, or
7 inside bank or slope of any road, street, or highway except as provided in this
8 chapter. Except in emergencies, an individual may not operate an off-highway
9 vehicle within the right of way of any controlled-access highway. An individual may
10 operate a registered off-highway vehicle on a gravel, dirt, or loose surface
11 roadway. An individual may operate a registered off-highway vehicle on a paved
12 highway designated and posted at a speed not exceeding fifty-five miles [88.51
13 kilometers] per hour an individual may operate a registered off-highway vehicle
14 with a solid hitch on the front of the vehicle designed to attach to a farm tractor on
15 a paved highway designated and posted at a speed not exceeding sixty miles
16 [104.61 kilometers] per hour. A licensed driver over sixteen years of age may
17 operate a registered class III off-highway vehicle on a paved highway designated
18 and posted at a speed not exceeding sixty-five miles [104.61 kilometers] per hour.
