1 A BILL for an Act providing an appropriation to the state historical society; and to provide
2 legislative intent.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
5 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$18,000,000, or so
6 much of the sum as may be necessary, out of any moneys in the permanent oil tax trust fund in
7 the state treasury, the sum of \$7,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, and
8 from special funds derived from federal funds and other income to the state historical society,
9 the sum of \$12,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state historical
10 society for the purpose of a heritage center addition.

11 **SECTION 2. CONSTRUCTION AUTHORIZATION.** Section 1 of this Act includes
12 \$25,000,000, of which \$18,000,000 is from the general fund and \$7,000,000 is from the
13 permanent oil tax trust fund, which the state historical society shall use for site work and for
14 construction of the heritage center building addition enclosed structure. Construction may not
15 begin until May 1, 2010, and until the state historical society certifies to the budget section that
16 fifty percent of the federal or special funds required to complete the project, up to \$6,000,000,
17 has been pledged to the state historical society.

18 **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS AND OTHER**
19 **INCOME.** It is the intent of the sixty-first legislative assembly that the \$12,000,000 of special
20 funds derived from federal funds or other income to the state historical society included in
21 section 1 of this Act be used for renovating the existing heritage center building, finishing the
22 lower level of the heritage center addition, and developing exhibits.

23 **SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - ADDITIONAL FUNDING.** It is the intent of the
24 sixty-first legislative assembly that the sixty-second legislative assembly provide additional

1 funding of \$14,700,000 from the general fund to complete the upper level of the heritage center
2 addition.

3 **SECTION 5. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO**
4 **SIXTY-SECOND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.** The following amounts reflect the 2009-11
5 one-time funding items included in section 1 of this Act:

11 The 2009-11 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the
12 2011-13 biennium. The state historical society shall report to the appropriations committees of
13 the sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium
14 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.
