3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.

- 1. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$3,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of providing grants to federally designated head start programs in this state, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. The head start state collaboration administrator shall award grants under this section based on an application and criteria that include:
 - The number of low-income children and families that a program can serve;
 - b. A program's design, its service area, and its accessibility to eligible children and families;
 - A program's coordination and interaction with private sector child care programs; and
 - d. Proposals for innovation that address identified needs among eligible children and families.
- To be eligible for a state grant under this section, each head start unit shall, to the
 extent possible, enroll uninsured eligible students for the most appropriate local,
 state, or federal insurance program available at no cost or reduced cost to the child
 or the child's family.
