- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study Indian education issues.
- 2 **WHEREAS**, the state's Indian reservations are some of the fastest growing areas of the
- 3 state; and
- 4 **WHEREAS**, a larger percentage of Indian youth remain in the state upon graduation
- 5 than do other youth; and
- 6 **WHEREAS**, a good quality education is essential for Indian youth to fully develop their
- 7 talents and contribute to the general welfare of the state of North Dakota; and
- 8 **WHEREAS**, many schools in Indian country are challenged by school finance issues;
- 9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE _____ OF**
- 10 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE _____ CONCURRING THEREIN:**
- 11 That the Legislative Council study Indian education issues; and
- 12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council assign this study to an
- 13 interim Education Committee or other similar interim committee for study; and
- 14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
- 15 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 16 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
