

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study space and facility needs of
2 state agencies to determine if efficiencies can be realized by constructing additional
3 state-owned facilities.

4 **WHEREAS**, the state of North Dakota maintains a State Capitol and Capitol complex
5 master plan; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the state of North Dakota leases office space in Bismarck for several of its
7 agencies and institutions; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the state should periodically evaluate office space needs and the cost of
9 leasing office space; and

10 **WHEREAS**, cost-savings may be realized by constructing additional facilities rather
11 than leasing space from private entities;

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
13 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

14 That the Legislative Council study the Capitol complex master plan and state agency
15 office space needs to determine if any efficiencies can be realized by constructing additional
16 facilities to house state agencies; and

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
18 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
19 the Sixty-second Legislative Assembly.
