- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the
- 2 adjutant general; to provide statements of legislative intent; to provide an appropriation; to
- 3 provide for transfers; and to provide an exemption.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 4

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the office of the adjutant general for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

- 6 The 2009-11 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the
- 7 2011-13 biennium. The adjutant general shall report to the appropriations committees of the
- 8 sixty-second legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium
- 9 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

SECTION 3. VETERANS' CEMETERY MAINTENANCE FUND - APPROPRIATION.

In addition to the amount appropriated to the adjutant general in the veterans' cemetery line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, there is appropriated any additional funds which are received and deposited in the veterans' cemetery maintenance fund pursuant to sections 37-03-14 and 39-04-10.10 for the operation of the North Dakota veterans' cemetery for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

section 4. Maintenance and Repairs - Transfers. The adjutant general may transfer to the operating expenses and capital assets line items contained in section 1 of this Act up to the sum of \$500,000 from the various other line items contained in section 1 of this Act, as determined necessary by the adjutant general to provide for the maintenance and repair of state-owned armories in this state during the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. Any amounts transferred pursuant to this section must be reported to the director of the office of management and budget.

SECTION 5. EXEMPTION. Funding of \$980,000 from the general fund appropriated for the computer-aided dispatch project, as contained in subdivision 2 of section 3 of chapter 42 of the 2007 Session Laws, is not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from these appropriations or related revenues are available and may be expended during the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - REINTEGRATION PROGRAM. It is the intent of the sixty-first legislative assembly that the adjutant general use all federal funds available for the reintegration program before using the \$848,537 appropriated for the program in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act. The funding for the program is to be used for providing

- support for all service members and their families for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and
 ending June 30, 2011.
- 3 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT STATE RADIO COMMUNICATIONS
- 4 **COVERAGE.** It is the intent of the sixty-first legislative assembly that the funding of \$500,000
- 5 appropriated in the radio communications line item in subdivision 2 of section 1 of this Act is for
- 6 improving state radio communications coverage in the state. Of the \$500,000, \$100,000 is for
- 7 conducting a study of the effects of next generation 911, \$75,000 is for alternatives to
- 8 constructing new state radio towers, and \$325,000 is for implementing a new state radio tower
- 9 site near Wales.
