**SENATE BILL NO.**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of job service North  
2 Dakota; and to amend and reenact section 52-02.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
3 relating to job service North Dakota program services.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the  
6 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state  
7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and  
8 other income, to job service North Dakota for the purposes of defraying the expenses of job  
9 service North Dakota, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as  
10 follows:

1           **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. - REED ACT FUNDS - UMEMPLOYMENT**

2   **INSURANCE COMPUTER MODERNIZATION.** The special appropriation of \$5,515,586 in  
3 section 1 of this Act is from federal Reed Acts made available to the state by the federal Reed  
4 Act distributions made in federal fiscal years 1957, 1958, 1999, and 2002, pursuant to section  
5 903 of the Social Security Act. This sum, or so much of sum as may be necessary, is for the  
6 purpose of developing a modernized unemployment insurance computer system, for the  
7 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

8           **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.** All federal funds received by job service North  
9 Dakota in excess of those funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act are appropriated, for the  
10 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

11           **SECTION 4. WORKFORCE 20/20 FUNDING.** Fifty percent of the workforce 20/20  
12 funding in section 1 of this Act must be used for projects for new or expanding businesses in  
13 North Dakota.
