- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the information
- 2 technology department.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the information technology department for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

22	SECTION 3. DEFERRED MAINTENANCE - TRANSFERS. The information					
23	technology department is authorized to transfer from the deferred maintenance line to the					
24	centers for distance education special line, contained in section 1 of this Act, amounts					
25	necessary to address extraordinary repair needs. Any amounts transferred must be reported to					
26	the director of the office of management and budget.					
27	SECTION 4. TRANSFER	RS. Notwithstanding se	ection 54-16-04, the c	director of the office		
28	of management and budget shall make transfers of funds between the salaries and wages,					
29	operating expenses, and capital assets line items in section 1 of this Act for the information					
30	technology department as may be requested by the chief information officer as determined					
31	necessary for the development and implementation of information technology projects.
