STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT:

This amendment removes a portion of funding included in the executive budget for compensation adjustments for employees of the North Dakota University System office. The Senate removed \$138,011 from the general fund related to compensation adjustments for

employees earning more than \$100,000 per year and the House restored this funding. This amendment restores \$30,029 from the general fund and removes \$6,440 of other funds to provide 3 percent annual compensation adjustments for all employees rather than 5 percent as provided for in the executive budget.
