4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the state department of health for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state department of health, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO SIXTY-SECOND LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time

- 1 funding items approved by the sixtieth legislative assembly for the 2007-09 biennium and the
- 2 2009-11 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$622,828, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of providing funding for suicide prevention, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. The state department of health is authorized one full-time equivalent position for this program.

SECTION 4. ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND. The estimated income line item included in section 1 of this Act includes \$272,310, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to be made available to the state department of health from the environment and rangeland protection fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. This amount includes \$50,000 for a grant to the North Dakota stockmen's association environmental services program.

SECTION 5. INSURANCE TAX DISTRIBUTION FUND. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes \$2,750,000 from the insurance tax distribution fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

SECTION 6. FEDERAL 319 NONPOINT PROGRAM MATCHING FUNDS - STATE WATER COMMISSION GRANT TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH. The state water commission shall provide a grant of \$200,000 from its 2009-11 biennium appropriation approved by the sixty-first legislative assembly to the state department of health to be used as matching funds for the federal 319 nonpoint program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011.

- 1 **SECTION 7. INTENT INDIRECT COST RECOVERIES.** Notwithstanding section
- 2 54-44.1-14, the state department of health may deposit indirect cost recoveries in its operating
- 3 account.
