Bismarck, March 10, 2009

CORRECTION AND REVISION OF THE JOURNAL

MR. SPEAKER: Your **Committee on Correction and Revision of the Journal (Rep. Delzer, Chairman)** has carefully examined the Journal of the 39th and 41st Days and recommends that it be corrected as follows and when so corrected, recommends that it be approved:

Last Saturday night the Red River High School Roughriders defeated the Bismarck Demons to win their 13th ND State High School Hockey Championship.

Rebounding from last year's overtime loss in the championship game to Grafton-Park River, and the loss of 14 players from that team made this year's championship the most improbable of any of the previous championship teams.

Finishing 3rd in the East Region during the season and entering the state tournament as the 3rd seed from the East Region did not deter the Roughriders from achieving what has become the standard at Red River High, the state championship.

Despite being outshot by a 30 - 12 margin in the final, the Roughriders rode the back of tournament MVP goaltender Aaron Meland and in fitting fashion, outstanding hockey winner Russel Crary scored the winning goal in the third period, capping the state title for the Roughriders.
