1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 4-37-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to the agriculture in the classroom council.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-37-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **4-37-02. Agriculture in the classroom council.**

- 7 1. An agriculture in the classroom council is established. The council consists of
8 ~~sixteen members to be appointed by the agriculture commissioner. One member~~
9 ~~must be the agriculture commissioner or the commissioner's designee, and one~~
10 ~~member must be the superintendent of public instruction or the superintendent's~~
11 ~~designee. Agriculture in the classroom grant recipients are nonvoting members of~~
12 ~~the council;~~
- 13 a. The agriculture commissioner or the commissioner's designee;
 - 14 b. One individual appointed by the superintendent of public instruction;
 - 15 c. One individual appointed by the state board for career and technical
16 education;
 - 17 d. One individual appointed by the governing body of the North Dakota farm
18 bureau;
 - 19 e. One individual appointed by the governing body of the North Dakota farmers
20 union;
 - 21 f. One individual appointed by the governing body of the North Dakota future
22 farmers of America;
 - 23 g. One individual appointed by the North Dakota ag coalition;

- 1 h. One individual appointed by the director of the North Dakota state university
2 extension service; and
- 3 i. Three teachers appointed for a term of two years by the agriculture
4 commissioner.
- 5 2. Recipients of agriculture in the classroom grants may serve as ex officio nonvoting
6 members of the council.
- 7 3. The three teachers appointed under subdivision i of subsection 1 may serve no
8 more than three consecutive terms.
- 9 4. The council shall provide for the election of a chairman from among its members
10 and shall adopt rules of operation and procedure.
