1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative council study.

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

3 **SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - HEALTH INSURANCE NEEDS -**

4 **REPORT.** During the 2009-10 interim, the legislative council shall conduct a comprehensive
5 study of unmet health care needs in the state. The study must include an assessment of the
6 needs of underinsured and uninsured individuals and families. In addition to considering the
7 federal health care initiatives, the study must include consultation with the state department of
8 health, the insurance commissioner, and the department of human services. The legislative
9 council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to
10 implement the recommendations, to the sixty-second legislative assembly.
