1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-03-35 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to the use of social security numbers on game and fish licenses and permits.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-03-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **20.1-03-35. Social Use of social security number to be furnished.** The social
7 ~~security number of an~~ director shall issue a distinguishing number to each applicant for any a
8 license or permit issued under this chapter which must be recorded on the application unless
9 ~~the applicant is a foreign national to whom no social security number has been issued. A social~~
10 ~~security number recorded under this section is confidential. Beginning on January 1, 2008, any~~
11 ~~application that is printed in paper form for a resident or nonresident fishing, hunting, or~~
12 ~~fur bearer certificate must be printed in a manner so that only the last four digits of the~~
13 ~~applicant's social security number are recorded on the application, and the first five digits of the~~
14 ~~applicant's social security number are not recorded on the application. The director may not~~
15 issue a distinguishing number that is, contains, can be converted to, or is an encrypted version
16 of the applicant's social security number unless specifically requested by the applicant.
