4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 6 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$5,000,000, or so
 - much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of commerce for the purpose of
 - providing a grant for construction of a great plains applied energy research center on the
- 9 Bismarck state college campus, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30,
- 10 2011. The department of commerce may spend the general fund appropriation only when the
- 11 department certifies to the office of management and budget that:
 - Other nonstate matching funds of three dollars for each one dollar of grant funds are available for all costs of the center, a portion of which must be from the private sector;
 - 2. The state will be a proportionate owner in the center based on the state's contribution percentage of all costs of the center;
 - The state will not be responsible for any future operational costs, including property tax, of the center; and
- 19 4. The center will be subject to local property tax assessments at the discretion of the local taxing authority.
- 21 **SECTION 2. REPORT TO THE BUDGET SECTION.** The department of commerce shall provide a report to the budget section at its first meeting after September 1, 2009, and at its first meeting after March 1, 2010, regarding the status of the construction of a great plans
