1 A BILL for an Act to provide for studies of the implementation of Indian treaty rights relating to
2 education, health, and welfare.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION AND STATE BOARD**
5 **OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO STUDY IMPLEMENTATION OF INDIAN TREATY RIGHTS**
6 **RELATING TO EDUCATION.** The superintendent of public instruction and the state board of
7 higher education shall conduct a study of the implementation of Indian treaty rights relating to
8 education. The superintendent of public instruction shall serve as lead entity for this study and
9 report the findings and recommendations of the study to the legislative council by September 1,
10 2010.

11 **SECTION 2. STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO STUDY IMPLEMENTATION OF**
12 **INDIAN TREATY RIGHTS RELATING TO HEALTH.** The state department of health shall
13 conduct a study of the implementation of Indian treaty rights relating to Indian health. The state
14 department of health shall report its findings and recommendations to the legislative council by
15 September 1, 2010.

16 **SECTION 3. DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO STUDY IMPLEMENTATION**
17 **OF INDIAN TREATY RIGHTS RELATING TO WELFARE.** The department of human services
18 shall conduct a study of the implementation of Indian treaty rights relating to welfare. The
19 department of human services shall report its findings and recommendations to the legislative
20 council by September 1, 2010.
