PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1012

In addition to the amendments adopted by the Senate as printed on pages 1317-1323 and pages 1331 and 1332 of the Senate Journal, Engrossed House Bill No. 1012 is further amended as follows:

Page 3, after line 6, insert:

"SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$6,277,888, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, and from special funds derived from federal funds, the sum of \$9,930,864, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of providing inflationary increases of seven percent for the second year of the biennium for rebased services and seven percent annual increases for all other services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011."

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT:

This amendment appropriates \$6,277,888 from the general fund and \$9,930,864 of special funds to the Department of Human Services for providing inflationary increases of 7 percent for the second year of the biennium for rebased services and 7 percent annual increases for all other services for the 2009-11 biennium.
