

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1019

Page 1, line 2, remove the second "and"

Page 1, line 4, after "grants" insert "; and to declare an emergency"

Page 4, after line 11, insert:

"SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FISCAL STIMULUS FUNDS - ADDITIONAL FUNDING APPROVAL. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated from federal funds made available to the state under the American Recover and Reinvestment Act of 2009, not otherwise appropriated, to the parks and recreation department, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

Grants for architectural and archaeological services at fort Abraham Lincoln	\$200,000
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The parks and recreation department may seek emergency commission and budget section approval under chapter 54-16 for authority to spend any additional federal funds received under the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 in excess of the amounts appropriated in this section, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2011.

Any federal funds appropriated under this section are not a part of the agency's 2011-13 base budget. Any program expenditures made with these funds will not be replaced with state funds after the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funds are no longer available.

SECTION 8. EMERGENCY. Section 7 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure."

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT:

This amendment provides appropriation authority to the Parks and Recreation Department to receive federal stimulus funds through the Transportation Enhancement grant program to provide grants to retain professional architectural and archaeological services relating to construction of the Tom Custer Company grade officers' quarters at Fort Abraham Lincoln.
