- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state
- 2 department of health; and to provide legislative intent.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the state department of health for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state department of health, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011, as follows:

## 9 **SECTION 3. ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND.** The 10 estimated income line item included in section 1 of this Act includes \$272,310, or so much of 11 the sum as may be necessary, to be made available to the state department of health from the 12 environment and rangeland protection fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, and 13 ending June 30, 2011. This amount includes \$50,000 for a grant to the North Dakota 14 stockmen's association environmental services program.

SECTION 4. INTENT - INDIRECT COST RECOVERIES. Notwithstanding section

54-44.1-14, the state department of health may deposit indirect cost recoveries in its operating account.
