4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 4-35.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Chemigation site permit - Fees.

- 1. Before any person may engage in chemigation, the person shall obtain from the commissioner a permit for each chemigation site. The commissioner shall develop a permit application form that requires:
 - a. The name and address of the applicant; and
- b. The legal description of the quarter section on which the irrigation system is
 situated.
 - A chemigation site permit issued under this section expires on June thirtieth of the third calendar year from the date of issuance.
 - 3. The commissioner shall charge a fee of thirty dollars for a chemigation site permit and shall forward any fees collected under this section to the state treasurer for deposit in the environment and rangeland protection fund.

SECTION 2. REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL. Before July 1, 2010, the
agriculture commissioner shall provide to the legislative council a report regarding the status of
rules adopted after June 30, 2009, which relate to chemigation through irrigation systems and
which must address check valves, secondary containment systems, and any other
